

Whalley Little League Major Division House Rules Regular Season 2024

Pre-game:

- The home team will provide both a scorekeeper and a pitch counter to run the scoreboard.
- Thirty minutes before game time, the home team will conduct a 10-minute infield/outfield session.
- Twenty minutes before game time, the visitors will take a 10-minute infield/outfield session.
- Umpires should be on the field 10 minutes before the game for the Little League Pledge, lineups, and warmup pitches. All Little League rules apply unless noted below.

Regular Season:

- 1. Minimum Play: All players, except 12-year-olds, will play at least one full game in every six games and at least 3 defensive innings in every game. 12-year-old playtime exceeding Little League minimums is based on merit.
- Batting Order: The tournament rule for continuous batting order and pinch/courtesy runners will apply except as it relates to defensive play and substitutions.
- 3. Game Substitutions: Game substitutions will occur after 3 full innings.
- 4. Mercy will be conceded per Rule 4(2) option 10 runs after 4 innings
- 5. Mercy Games/Shortened Games: In the event a player plays less than 3 full innings, they will start the next game.
- 6. Warming Up Pitchers: When warming up pitchers between innings or in the bullpen, a player in full catcher's gear must do the catching. Coaches are not allowed to warm up pitchers.
- 7. Bullpen: Players not currently in the game may practice pitching in the bullpen. The catcher must be a player in full catcher's gear, and the 3rd player must act as a spotter. If there isn't an available player to provide a spotter, then a coach may act as a spotter.

- 8. 12 Player Roster: Teams must carry 12 players all year long. In the event a player quits or will miss more than 4 weeks due to an injury, the team must pick up a player from the Minor Division to fill out their roster.
- 9. Tie Games: Games tied after 6 innings will be played out per little league rule 14(b) starting in the 7th inning.
- 10. Coach Position: All coaches must be in the base coach box or at or beyond the first gate of the dugout and may only approach the umpire with permission.
- 11. Ejection from the game will result in suspension for the remainder of the regular season unless the coach meets with league representatives to determine otherwise.

Playoffs: Placement from Regular Season:

- 1. Winning percentage (% points earned of total points played), thereby eliminating rainout ties
- 2. If two teams are tied, then head-to-head records.
- 3. If more than two teams are tied, total runs against vs. the teams that are tied.
- 4. If still tied, then plus/minus runs for and against.
- 5. If still tied, then a coin toss.

Playoff Rules:

- 1. Playoff format will be a round robin format with semi-finals between seed 1 vs. 4 and 2 vs. 3. The winners of the semi-final games advance to a final game. There will be no consolation game for third and fourth place.
- 2. Tiebreakers for Round Robin:
 - Head-to-head play between the two teams.
 - If more than two teams are tied, then least runs against per inning played.
 - If still tied, then plus-minus in runs.
 - If still tied, then a coin toss (a playoff game may be played here if it determines participation in the final).
- 3. Pitch counts carry over and continue from the Regular season to playoffs.
- 4. Little League Tournament rules apply except for:
 - Minimum play is same as regular season except no mandatory full games.
- 5. A coin toss will determine the home team.

- 6. Games tied after 6 innings will be played out per little league rule 14(b) starting in the 7th inning.
- 7. Rainouts will be played at the end of the round-robin schedule if needed. Rainout games will be played ONLY if the results impact which two teams will advance to the final.

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
